Cutting

6 1/2 Center Square

Fabric A:

Cut 4, 4 1/4 inch squares

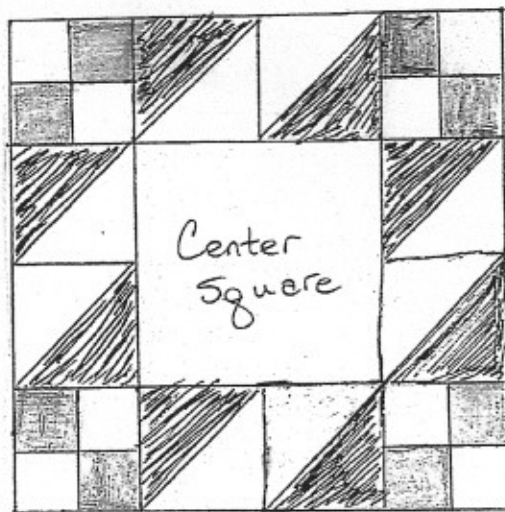
Cut 1, 17 x 2 inch strip

Fabric B:

Cut 4, 4 1/4 inch squares

Fabric C:

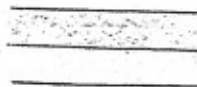
Cut 1, 17 x 2 inch strip



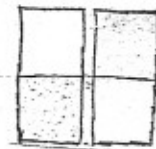
Piecing

Four-patch units:

1. Sew long edges of Fabric A and Fabric C 15 x 2 strips together. Press towards the darker fabric.



2. Cut this strip into 8, 2" strips. Matching opposite corners, sew 2 strips together to create 4, 3 1/2 x 3 1/2 four-patch squares. Refer to picture of square.

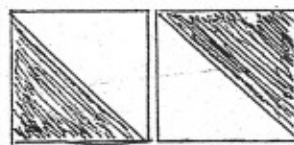


Half Square Triangle Units:

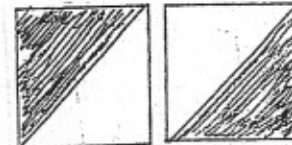
1. Using Fabric A and Fabric B, 4 1/4" squares, make 8 Triangle Squares. Square to 3 1/2".



2. Connect 2 of these triangle squares with Fabric A triangles in the middle and the Fabric B triangles in opposite corners. Refer to picture of square. Make 4 of these half square triangle units.

Assembly

- 1) Sew a Half Square Triangle Unit to each side edge of the center square.
- 2) Sew a Four-Patch unit to each side edge of the remaining Half Square Triangle Units. Match diagonal patches. Sew these units to the top and bottom edges of the Center square unit.
- 3) Your square should now measure 12 1/2"
