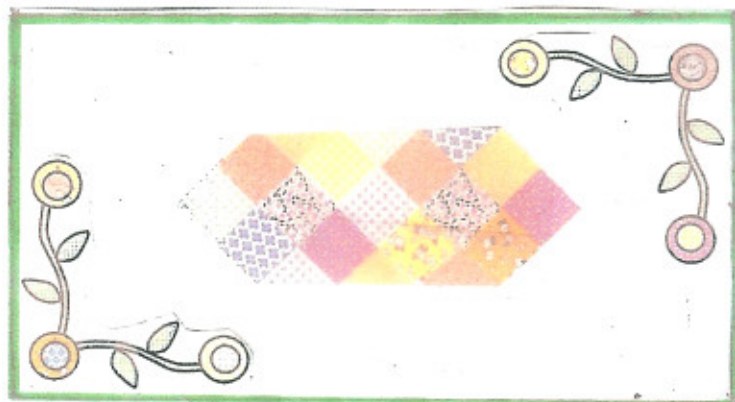


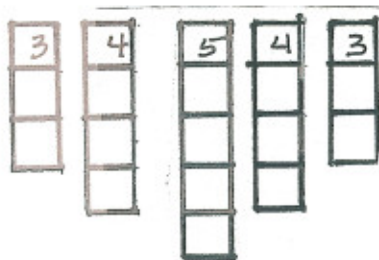
Charming Table Runner

19 x 38 As Directed

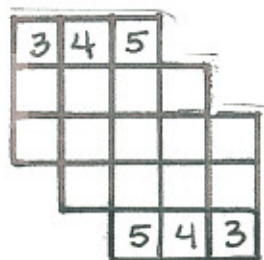
- 19, 5 inch charm squares
- 6 - 8, 5 inch charm squares or scrap fabric for Yo-Yo flowers
- Jumbo Green rick/rack for stems or green fabric for stems
- Green Fabric for leaves
- Buttons for embellishing
- ½ Yard White on White fabric for borders
- 1/3 Yard of fabric for binding
- 22" x 40" piece of batting
- 22" x 40" piece of backing fabric



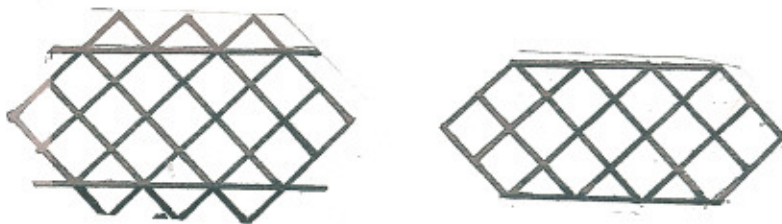
1. Sew the 19 charms into strips of 3, 4, 5, 4 and 3.



2. Join these strips together in this configuration: 3, 4 and 5 matching the top and then 4 and 3 matching the bottom of 5.



3. Position the above unit on a cutting mat and make a long hexagon by cutting off the three points on each long side.

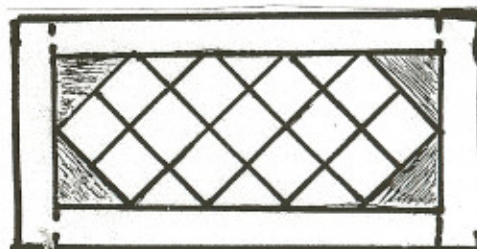


4. From background fabric cut 2, 7 ½" squares. Cut these squares in half on the diagonal. Attach the resulting triangles to the corners of the hexagon to create a long rectangle.

5. From background fabric cut 3 ½ inch strips for border. Sew to top.



6. Sandwich the top, batting and backing.

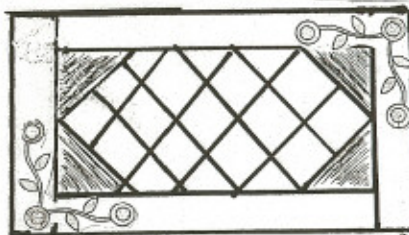
7. Quilt the table runner.

8. From scraps, make 12 Yo-Yos (6 large and 6 small).

9. Make bias tape for stems or use rick/rack. If using bias tape, bias should be ¼" to ½" wide.

10. Cut 8 leaves from green fabric.

11. Machine or hand appliqué the flowers, leaves and stems on the table runner.



12. Bind and enjoy your Charming Table Runner.

Yo-Yo Instructions: From accent fabrics, trace 6 large and 6 small circles. Cut circles ¼" from tracing lines. From wrong side, turn under the ¼" edge and finger press. Run a long gathering stitch on the traced line or fold. Make large stitches in order to minimize the opening of the Yo-Yo. Turn right side out, gather tightly, flatten, and adjust gathers. Push needle through the center, and knot on back.

****Option #2 for table runner -** In order to make the table runner longer, just add more strips of 5 to the center.

****Option #3 for table runner –** Cut charm squares into 4" squares by taking a 1" x 5" strip off one side and a 1" x 4" strip from the second side. Sew the 4" squares as directed. Add a 1" border of the background fabric. Piece the 1" strips and make a 2nd border for the table runner. Finish by adding the remaining 3 ½" border.
