

January 2011 Project Click Bag

Supplies:

1. Basic sewing kit
2. The amount of fabric will vary depending on the size of bag you plan to make:
 a = size of opening no bigger than 10" and will be about $\frac{1}{4}$ " smaller than c
 b and c : these dimensions are up to you.

3. Fabric for the outside: $2 \times [(b+1'') \times (c+1'')]$
 If you would like the outside of the bag to be quilted you can use a pre-quilted fabric or quilt your outside fabric with thin batting only; do not quilt including the lining!

4. Fabric for the lining: $2 \times [(b+1'') \times (c+1'')]$

5. Fabric for the closure: $2 \times [(a+1'') \times 4'']$
 For a very small bag: $2 \times [(a+1'') \times 2'']$
 (small bag = coin purse maybe)



6. Example: finished bag 8" wide = c and 6" deep = b ; so $a = c - \frac{1}{4}'' = 7 \frac{3}{4}''$.
 Cut: two pieces for the outside fabric and two pieces for the lining measuring each: $(b + 1'') \times (c + 1'') = (6'' + 1'') = 7'' \times 9''$. For the closure cut two pieces of fabric measuring each: $(a + 1'') \times 2'' = (7 \frac{3}{4}'' + 1'') \times 2'' = 8 \frac{3}{4}'' \times 2''$.
 If you would like your bag to look quilted, now is the time to quilt the two pieces of outside fabric, but do not quilt them with the lining! Just quilt the outside fabric and some batting.
