

2012 Community Service Quilt

Supplies:

$\frac{3}{4}$ yd print fabric

$\frac{3}{4}$ yd central theme fabric (provided by guild)

From Print Fabric: Cut 4 – 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ” strips (length of fabric – approximately 42 in.) Print fabric sub-cut into 24 – 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ ” X 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ” strips (length of fabric – approximately 42 in.)

Cut 6 - 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ” strips (length of fabric – approximately 42 in.) print fabric sub-cut into 24 – 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ X 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ strips

From Solid Theme Fabric: Cut 24 – 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ ” X 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ ” blocks fabric (provided by guild)

Sew one 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ” X 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ strip to the top of one of the blocks. Press toward strip.

Sew one 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ” X 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ ” strip to the side of the block. The two strips will form an “L”. Press toward strip.

Blocks should measure 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ ” X 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ ”

Do this for the 24 blocks.

Assemble blocks 4 across and 6 down, making sure you put one border strip next to one block without a border strip. Blocks will not all be facing the same way, creating an offset look.

Quilt should measure approximately 32 $\frac{3}{4}$ ” by 48 $\frac{1}{2}$ ” when completed.

Add borders to make quilt 40-42” X 50-60” finished.
